


The College shall also comply with the following Rule 16 in Section B in Part IV of the Bar Council of India Rules:

"Whenever approval of affiliation is granted to the law college it shall be necessary for the college to deposit in cash Rs.1,00,000/- (one lakh) in the shape of guarantee to fulfil all the norms of the Bar Council of India. The same shall be liable to be forfeited if the norms are not complied with and the same shall carry no interest."

The approval of affiliation now granted by the Bar Council of India is subject to the payment of guarantee amount as mentioned in the above rule.

You are also required to apply to the Bar Council of India for further extension of approval of affiliation six months in advance before expiry of the period of approval of affiliation granted by the Bar Council of India.

Legal Education Committee at its meeting held on 19<sup>th</sup> December, 2009 considered the inspection report of the above mentioned college and Committee made the following recommendations:-


“Legal Education Committee considered the inspection report of Lok Bandhu Rajnarayan Law College, Varanasi, UP submitted by the inspection team of the Bar Council of India. After consideration Committee is of the view that extension of approval of affiliation to the above mentioned college be granted for a period of three years i.e. from the academic session 2009-2010 to 2011-2012 for imparting three year law course with existing strength of students subject to the following conditions:-

1. The college authority has to purchase law textbooks, journals, periodical and Indian Bar Review worth Rs. 1 lakh immediately, and continue to purchase books worth Rs. 50,000/- every year.
2. The college management shall pay salary to the faculties as per the UGC norms.
3. Two more teaching staffs to be appointed.
4. The college authority should strictly follow the new rules framed by the Bar Council of India Rules.

Further, Committee makes it clear that as per the new rules of the Bar Council of India relating to Legal Education, maximum intake in one section should be 60 students from the academic year 2009-2010 and therefore college authorities are directed to admit only 60 students in one section from the coming session i.e. 2009-2010. In case number of students exceed the limit now prescribed as per existing strength of number of sections such additional students already admitted may be permitted to continue in the additional section keeping in view the staff and infrastructure available to the college concerned.

The above recommendations were considered by the Bar Council of India at its meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> December, 2009 and accepted the same.

College authorities are also required to apply to the Bar Council of India for further extension of approval of affiliation six months in advance before expiry of the period of approval of affiliation granted by the Bar Council of India.


The Report of Inspection of the above college was placed before the Legal Education Committee at its meeting held on 1<sup>st</sup> February 2008 and Committee made the following recommendations :-

“Legal Education Committee considered the inspection report of Lok Bandhu Raj Narayan Vidhi Mahavidyalaya, Varanasi, U.P. submitted by the inspection team of the Bar Council of India. After consideration Committee is of the view that the above mentioned college may be granted extension of approval of affiliation for a period of two years i.e. for the academic sessions 2007-2008 and 2008-2009 for imparting three year law course with existing strength subject to the following conditions:

1. College authorities are required to purchase the current law text books including journals and Indian Bar Review worth Rs.50,000/- in each academic session.
2. Management shall pay U.G.C. pay scale to the faculty members through cheques.
3. Existing building which is being used shall have to be renovated and flooring of the class rooms, lobby and library shall also be built with concrete or mosaic.
4. Administrative block of the said college be constructed within one year as proposed by the management team.
5. Management is required to file the compliance of the conditions by way of an affidavit.”

The above recommendations were considered by the Bar Council of India at its meeting held on 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2008 and accepted the same.

You are also required to apply to the Bar Council of India for further extension of approval of affiliation six months in advance before expiry of the period of approval of affiliation granted by the Bar Council of India.

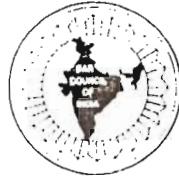

The Report of Inspection submitted by the inspection team of the Bar Council of India, Compliance reports submitted by the Principal of above law college in respect of inspection report and your letter dated 17.12.2004 were considered by the Legal Education Committee at its meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> February, 2005 and after consideration Committee made the following recommendations:-

"Legal Education Committee considered the compliance reports submitted by the Principal, Lok Bandhu Rajnarayan Vidhi Mahavidyalaya, Varanasi, UP and also the letter dated 17.12.2004 received from the Registrar . After consideration Committee is of the view that the above mentioned college may be granted temporary approval of affiliation for imparting three year law course for a period of three years i.e. from the academic year 2004-2005 to 2006-2007 with intake of two sections of 80 students in each section."

The above recommendations were considered by the Bar Council of India at its meeting held on 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> February, 2005 and accepted the same.
